- Display appropriate behavior, especially in language, dress, and obedience. You are a role model for the middle school students.
- be flexible and adaptable as plans change.
- Take responsibility not only for your own behavior, but the behavior of your small group.
- Take a leadership role each week in administrative tasks and organization of your small group.

- Arrive by 7:30AM and plan to leave no earlier than 5:00PM unless prearranged and approved by Bri.

- Participate enthusiastically and appropriately in prayer, Mass and Adoration.
