

Funeral Luncheons

DESCRIPTION OF MINISTRY:

This rewarding ministry assists people in their time of sorrow, by assisting in serving the luncheon to the family and their guests.

COMMITMENT:

--**Meetings/Activity Commitment**: There is not a scheduled commitment with this ministry – it's just one you can assist with if you are available when there will be a funeral. Volunteers are called two to three days ahead of time to see if they could help. A funeral luncheon is usually a 3 hour commitment.

--**Commitment Length**: No timeframe. Volunteer for this ministry for as long as you like. If you don't want to assist, just ask that your name be taken off the volunteer list.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THIS MINISTRY:

--**Training**: Working around and with the experienced volunteers is usually the way you get to know what needs to be done. Virtus Training and a background check are also required before serving funeral luncheons.

--**Skills**: Usual funeral luncheons require setting the tables with table cloths, flowers, etc., making coffee and lemonade, getting ice water ready. Helping to set up the main table for the caterer, and preparing the desserts for the dessert table. Assist guests with their food and drinks. Pick up, put away after guests leave.
