COMMITMENT:

--**Meetings/Activity Commitment**: Attendance and active involvement in our weekly Tuesday sessions, which meet from mid-Sept. through mid-May from 7:00-9:00 P.M. There will also be RCIA rites and retreats for you to attend and participate in that will involve a few weekend commitments as well.

--**Commitment Length**: That is entirely up to you. We have team members who serve any where from 1-5 or more years.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THIS MINISTRY:

--**Training**: No training requirements; just have a desire to share in the faith journeys of those going through RCIA. Virtus training and background checks may be necessary for certain volunteer situations.

--**Skills**: Willingness to share your faith and welcome those seeking to grow in their faith.
